Luddington Parish Council

Some residents may have spotted on Warwickshire County Council's Roadworks App that work on the Bordon Hill Roundabout is due to start on 8th April for 12 months. Luddington Parish Council have queried this and Stratford District Council have advised:

"Although consented through the planning application for Shottery, Warwickshire County Council will be carrying out the works themselves in respect of this roundabout. Once technical approval is in place, WCC will need to go out to tender and select the contractor."

Luddington Parish Council will be monitoring the situation and have asked for information relating to the Traffic Management Plan that Bloor/Hallam are legally required to submit as the stopping-up of the Evesham Road due to this construction may have a serious impact on increasing traffic through the village and Luddington Road.
